Sharing the Light

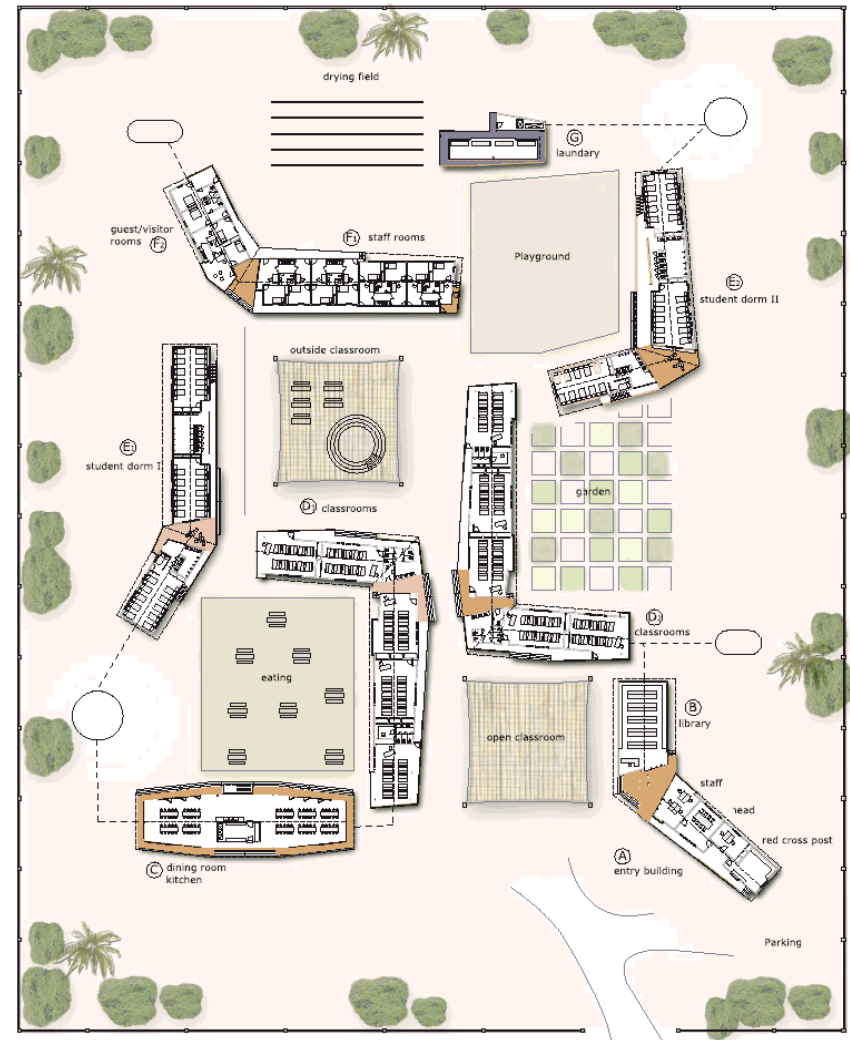
The Academy

The MCF Academy will be the first school in Liberia to provide free education, including room and board, to its students. When the school opens in 2010, the 75 abandoned children from the DuPort Road community, who are currently enrolled MCF's sponsorship program, will transfer to the MCF Academy, and 125 additional orphans or abandoned children will be admitted based on need and merit.

The Academy will allow MCF to further its mission to empower Liberian youth, especially orphans and abandoned children, by providing education and the basic necessities of food, clothing, and shelter. Our vision is to give as many Liberian children as possible the chance to escape the poverty cycle and grow in the nurturing environment of an MCF Academy, so that they can lead Liberia toward an economically strong and politically stable future.

Fundraising Goal: \$500,000

In 2009, MCF will host various fundraisers to support the building of the Academy. February 20th's kick-off event in New York City during Fashion Week will be followed by fundraisers in the Hamptons and Philadelphia.
